About the Pantry

Salem United Methodist Church (UMC) and its United Methodist Women (UMW) are sponsoring a food pantry for families experiencing food insecurity. The mission is to deliver nutritious food to persons who are homebound, experiencing an emergency food need, unemployed, working poor, Backpack Pals, or school age children with no access to summer feeding programs in eastern Pitt County.

We are in partnership with the Food Bank of Eastern and Central North Carolina, The Emergency Food Assistance Program, and a Retail Recovery Program with Food Lion. In addition, we are supported by food and monetary donations from Salem United Methodist Church, its members and friends.

Who Qualifies:

- **Must meet poverty level by proof of receipt of food stamps, verification of food stamps pending, or reporting income.**
- Registration form must be completed.
